# Great Schools Colorado-CSP Prospect Cohort Kicks Off with First Meeting

The Great Schools Colorado-CSP Prospect Cohort held its first meeting on February 11th, introducing charter school developers to the federally funded program. Participants from nine charter schools/networks discussed the initiative's mission to expand high-quality



charter schools for underserved students. The session covered program objectives, funding allocation, the estimated competition timeline for Year 1 awards in Spring 2025, and the importance of strong charter school authorizing processes. Attendees also learned about available technical assistance, grant types, and funding structures to support planning and implementation.

In case you are just hearing about this learning community presented by the League, this cohort supports charter developers, school leaders, and board members seeking startup funding through the Great Schools Colorado grant. Focused on new, replication, or expansion projects, it meets monthly, covering key topics based on project timelines and group priorities.
